

## “Christianity in the History of U.S.-China Relations”

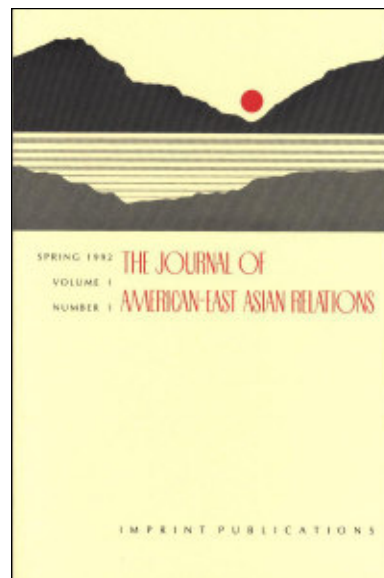
